





Forgiveness In Ramadan

Once when the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was sitting in the Mosque with a group of his companions, he caught everyone by surprise by stating that the next person to enter the sanctuary would be a person of paradise. The Prophet's companions waited eagerly to see who it would be. Finally, a rather simple man by the name of Abu Dumdum appeared. The companions were befuddled because they didn't think that this person was extraordinarily pious. One of the companions asked Abu Dumdum if he could stay with him for a few nights making an excuse of need. In reality, he just wanted to know what was so special about Abu Dumdum. In the night the companion expected Abu Dumdum to pray all night - but no such thing happened. During the day, the companion expected Abu Dumdum to fast, but that didn't happen either. Finally, the companion told Abu Dumdum about what the Prophet (PBUH) had said and why he was spending nights in his home. Abu Dumdum replied that the only thing he did that was different and unique was before going to bed every night he would forgive anyone who had offended him knowingly or unknowingly would go to sleep with a clean heart toward others. Forgiveness in the Arabic language is related to the word "covering". When Allah (Mighty and Sublime) forgives His servants' sins, those sins are covered on their books of bad deeds as if those sins never took place. Hence when believers filled with compassion truly forgive those who have wronged them, they cover-up in their hearts the wrong that was done to them, not bringing those wrongs up to browbeat people with later or to use as leverage against them. Sincere forgiveness is to not harbor animosity against those who have done us wrong. Having mercy for others is in not punishing them when allowed. Forgiving those who have wronged us benefits the merciful and forgiving ones, just as benefit comes to the ones shown compassion and forgiveness. There's a deep sense that the way we treat others is the way that we will be treated by God. In other words, if we wish for Allah's gentle treatment toward us then we must be gentle toward others. We are not physical beings exclusively. We are spiritual beings housed in a physical container. The physical body has its life and we have obligations to it, but it will be left behind. We can't let this physical body dominate the narrative. Although we tend to think of the mind, body, and spirit as separate components, in reality, they are all connected and interrelated, and improvement in any one naturally affects improvement in the others as well. Forgiving in Ramadan purifies the mind, body, and spirit, leading to greater clarity, sensitivity, and health. This Ramadan, let's try and forgive everyone who has hurt us. It shows strength, self-confidence,







The Covid-19 pandemic had rendered the Hajj for 2020 impossible for millions around the world. This will be the smallest number of Hujaaj in living memory. Let us pray that Allaah SWT will allow a universal cure that will save lives and make it safe for Hajj this year, In Sha-Allaah. Say, "Ameen!"In this short article, I want to sum up a few key points for us to remember about this momentous event. Haii, the pilgrimage to Makkah, is an epic journey. It is the 5th and final pillar of Islam: It also summarizes the dramatic story of our beautiful Deen.Hajj reminds us about our primordial human nature: our Fitra. Fitra is our natural state, the way Allaah SWT made us. We were born innocent and pure, without sin. However, Allaah SWT also made us to be forgetful. We are easily distractible. It is our tendency to lose focus and to forget that leads us to slide into sinful and shameful behavior.But then Hajj also offers us Redemption, divine Mercy and Forgiveness. Allaah SWT reminds us never to despair of His Mercy. If we sincerely stop our bad behavior and return to Allaah SWT's obedience, His forgiveness is complete.Hajj takes us on a journey back through time, retelling the moral and spiritual history of humankind. We visit the Kaaba, the first place of worship, built before the first church, before the first temple, or synagogue. Here we find ourselves at the Baytul-Laah, the House of Allaah SWT. It is the home of Monotheism, the cradle of Tawheed, of Divine Unity. Here we walk around the geographical center of Islam, the Kaaba. This is center of our Islamic universe.Our tawaaf symbolizes effort, action, in a constant, circular motion, centered round a fixed and immovable idea of Unity: Just like the Kaaba, Tawheed. Unity of belief, Unity of purpose, stands firm amidst a swirl of individual opinions and different starting points. The great plains of Arafat become the stage for a dramatic role-play of the very beginning and the very end: Long before time and space existed, long before the 'big bang' 14 billion years ago, Allaah SWT created your soul and my soul and the souls of every human being that ever was and ever will be. Then He asked them to testify according to themselves, by declaring the First Shahaadah, the First Covenant. This was in the state of metaphysical time, or pre-Eternal Time. When Allaah SWT addressed the great-assembled gathering of human Souls, he asked them: "Alastu bi Rabbikum?" "Am I not Your Lord?"

Although this was given to us more than 1400 years ago, the teachings are applicable today as it was then. 
QUESTION & ANSWER CORNER

DO YOUR BEST WITH OURBANI / SACRIFICE

<u>QUESTION</u>: What's recommended when doing Qurbaani / Sacrifice?

ANSWER: Alhamdulillaah The following are some references pertaining to your questions: Sahih Al-Bukhari -Narrated byAl Bara - The Prophet (S.A.W) said (on the day of Id-al-Adha), "The first thing we will do on this day of ours, is to offer the ('Id) prayer and then return to slaughter the sacrifice. Whoever does so, he acted according to our Sunna (tradition), and whoever slaughtered (the sacrifice) before the prayer, what he offered was just meat he presented to his family, and that will not be considered as Nusak (sacrifice)." (On hearing that) Abu Burda bin Niyar got up, for he had slaughtered the sacrifice before the prayer, and said, "I have got a six month old ram." The Prophet said, 'Slaughter it (as a sacrifice) but it will not be sufficient for any-one else (as a sacrifice after you)." Al-Bara' added: The Prophet said, "Whoever slaughtered (the sacrifice) after the prayer, he slaughtered it at the right time and followed the tradition of the Muslims." Conditions for Sacrifice : A sacrificial animal should satisfy the following conditions: 1. It should be two years old, if it is an animal other than a sheep. As for sheep, even a six month old lamb may be sacrificed, but it should be fat and healthy. As for a camel, it must be at least five years old, a cow two years old, and a goat a year old at least. 2. It should be healthy and free from all physical defects. It should not be one eyed, nor should it limp, be mangy, or very thin and weak. Selecting One's Own Sacrificial Animal Malik has reported from Hisham bin 'Urwah and he from his father that he used to tell his sons: "O my sons! Do not slaughter an animal in the name of Allah such as you will be embarrassed to present as a gift to a close and respected friend of yours. Allah is the Most Honorable and Most Generous, and He is the most deserving to be offered the best of what you have." 

The Concept Of Ummah

The difficulty was felt towards the end of the seventeenth century when, in the West, geography and territoriality became central to the idea of state with the development of the concept of the nation-state and the downfall of papal authority in Europe. With the fall of the Church as the unifying force and controlling power of Christian Europe and the resultant disintegration of the papal administration, eventually militant territorial nationalism emerged and led to the total dismemberment of the Church Empire and the establishment of strong nation-states throughout Europe. All this had its fallout on Muslim thought and Muslim political thinking. From this point onwards, there were increasing encounters between Islam and the West, which kept intensifying and diversifying with the passage of time. Muslim thinkers came more and more under the influence of Western ideas through a number of avenues. It was from this background that nationalism and territoriality came to be acknowledged by Muslims as the major elements of the composition of the state. No doubt, the increasing appeal to the idea of the nation-state had a negative effect on the concept of ummah and the unity of the Dar al-Islam. Territorial nationality became a decisive factor in the political debate, not only in the West but also in the East. It continued to acquire more and more influence, until, in time, the very concept of ummah, as defined by early Muslim scholars and maintained by later generations, was desecrated. (Ahmad, Baihaqi), likely on the last night of the month. Calling For Justice

O ye who believe! stand out firmly for justice, as witnesses to Allah, even as against yourselves, or your parents, or your kin, and whether it be (against) rich or poor: for Allah can best protect both. Follow not the lusts (of your hearts) lest ye swerve and if ye distort (justice) or decline to do justice, verily Allah is well-acquainted with all that ye do. (4:135)When giving dawah, often we discuss topics such as tawheed, the Quran, prayer, and fasting. We will tell stories of the Holy Prophet (S) and the early Muslims and outline how Islam differs from other faiths. However, Islam is about more than theology or daily rituals, it is a religion that is meant to touch all aspects of life and to address ills within society. Standing up against injustice is the duty of every Muslim, and one of the most powerful ways we can call others to Islam. Injustice exists in every country and within every society. Recently the world has seen terrible injustice carried out in Palestine. The Palestinian people have been subject to ethnic cleansing for nearly a century, yet many in our Ummah are afraid to speak out for them. The Uygurs in China and the Rohingya in Myanmar have been subject to the most brutal forms of cruelty, yet many in our Ummah do not speak out for them. It is our responsibility to speak out against injustice not only when it is committed against Muslims, but non-Muslims as well. When we see racial discrimination, poverty, brutality, violence, or any form of oppression, it is our responsibility to call for justice. In Surat Al-Nisa, Allah (SWT) tells us: "O ye who believe! stand out firmly for justice, as witnesses to Allah, even as against yourselves, or your parents, or your kin, and whether it be (against) rich or poor" (4:135). The Quran clearly states here that it is the responsibility of the believers to stand for justice, no matter who it is for. We should stand for justice even if we fear that doing so is not to our benefit. Many Muslims are afraid to speak out due to being labeled as "too political" or they may fear difficulties like not being able to find a job or not being promoted at work. However, when have tawakkul on Allah (SWT), complete trust in Allah (SWT), those fears should not stand in our way. When we call out for justice, in reality we are calling out the message of



(TRIP) (Traveler Redress Inquiry Program)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Traveler Redress Inquiry Program (TRIP) is a procedure to allow persons who have experienced difficulties during their travel screening at airports or crossing U.S. land borders to address the issues and prevent future problems upon entry. Homeland Security says this program is part of an effort by the departments of State and Homeland Security to welcome legitimate travelers while still securing our country from those who want to do us harm. When going through immigration some people are pulled aside and sent to "secondary" inspection because something has been flagged in their record. This can be a result of a mistaken identity, a travel record that did not properly record your timely exit from the country and incorrectly showsthat you overstayed your authorized time on a previous entry or other mistaken derogatory information that is shown on your record. Secondary inspection can also be caused by fingerprints that were incorrect or of poor quality along with a myriad of other issues. Secondary inspection may also be a result of random screening and what some believe is based on bias towards certain groups of people. Secondary inspection can result in missing connecting flights or being stuck for hours at the airport after a long trip. DHS indicates that they will work

with you to resolve travel-related issues when:

-You were not able to print a boarding pass from an airline ticketing kiosk or from the Internet

-You were denied or delayed boarding

-A ticket agent "called someone" before handing you a boarding pass -You were told:

-your fingerprints were incorrect or of poor quality

-your photo did not match the travel document

- -your personal information was incomplete or inaccurate
- -you are on the "No Fly List"

-You want to

-amend a traveler record because of an overstay as a result of not submitting the required I-94 when exiting the United States -Ensure your biometric record in the Department of Homeland Security Systems is corrected if inaccurate.

-You believe

-you were unfairly detained during your travel experience or unfairly denied entry into the United States

-the U.S. government's record of your personal information is

inaccurate

It should be noted that the TRIP program does not address travel issues related to mishandled bags or poor customer service. In order to use DHS Trip to resolve future problems in travel, one may complete an online form and provide information about the problem and documentation that they believe would resolve the issue. The form and documentation may also be mailed but TRIP is processed more quickly if done online. One may also have an attorney handle this for you. DHS Trip is not a difficult process but may save you a great deal of



An Indian spice called $\underline{\textit{turmeric}}$ is a powerful healing root is very effective in healing and

curing inflammation, lowering the sugar level, blood pressure, and tumors.Turmeric's principle polyphenol called **curcumin** could be used in place of statins, steroids diabetics drugs, chemo, and antidepressants.In 2009, researches found that **curcumin** activates AMPK (5' Adenosine Mono-phosphateactivated protein kinase, is an enzyme that plays a role in cellular energy homeostasis) allowing for increased glucose uptake.

A 2015 study published in *Phytotherapy Research* found even more promising results in humans with major depressive disorders. A Curcumin and piperine combination significantly reduced depression symptoms in human patients andhad the greatest effects on middle-aged patients for longer duration of administration and at higher doses.

Curcumin in **reversing liver disease:** Curcumin possesses such great antioxidant and anti-inflammatory effects, it can reverse liver disease caused by excessive alcohol consumption. In one animal study published in the *Journal of Biochemical and Molecular* Toxicology, a formulation of curcumin-galactomannosides reversed all the pathological effects of alcohol consumption, including elevated liver toxicity markers, lipid peroxidation and inflammatory markers with a simultaneous reduction in antioxidant defenses.

<u>Curcumin and Chemotherapy:</u> When Chemotherapy fails Curcumin heals:

A 2010 study published in TNO Nutrition and Food Research found that Curcumin has value in treating cancer cells lines that do not respond to chemotherapy.Two multi-drug resistant proteins, MRP1 and MRP2, were both inhabited by curcumin and its glutathione-dependent metabolism. In conjugation, a study from the University of Belgrade, republic of Serbia showed that high doses of curcumin shut down multi-drug resistant nonsmall cell lung carcinoma cell lines. A synergistic cytotoxic effect was observedwhen curcumin was combined with Sulfonimine.

<u>Plant based medicine</u> such as cannabis have opened the door and provided an outlet for more plant based antioxidants and polyphenols to enter the medical field. Turmeric is at the forefront of revolutionizing medicine. With hundreds of peer reviewed biomedical studies proving its efficacy in various medical applications, turmeric should finally be embraced by failing Western medicine practices.

Hajj (The Annual Pilgrimage)

"Alastu bi Rabbikum?" "Am I not Your Lord?" They all replied, in one thunderous voice, "Balaa shahidna", "Yes, indeed! We testify to this, so that we have no excuse on the Day of Judgement to say that we were not aware of this (covenant)." [Sura Ar'af 7:172] That was the very beginning. What about the very end? The great gathering on Arafat is our Day of Atonement. It is also a dress rehearsal for the Day of Judgement, Yawmul giyyaamah. This is how the entire human race will one day stand before Allaah SWT, awaiting the Final Judgement. In our simple ehram clothes, we cannot distinguish anyone's wealth and social status. No one can see who is rich and who is poor; the president, the billionaire, the taxi driver, the school teacher and the farmer all look the same. This is exactly as Allaah SWT sees us. Allaah SWTis not looking at our social status or our designer clothes and expensive jewelry. Allaah SWTis not interested in what is on the outside, only what is inside. What is inside our hearts? What desires, what hidden yearnings are lurking in the deepest depths of our being? Is it full of anger, jealousy, hatred, vanity and lust? Or is it full of love, mercy, and generosity? Are we patient and forbearing towards others? Have we purified our spiritual hearts? Do we have a Qalb saleem? A pure, sound heart? Allaah SWT warns us that no one shall enter the Garden except those who come with a sound heart. [Quran 26:87-89] We come to Jabal *Rahma*: the Mount of Mercy, a low hill rising above the plain of 'Arafat. Jabal Rahma signifies the central theme of atonement, forgiveness after we have acknowledged our sins and pleaded for Allaah SWT's mercy. Here we follow the Adamic role model. Here we stand not simply as Muslims or Believers. Here we stand as Bani Adam, descendants of Adam and Eve. Here is where the first human beings sought forgiveness and this is where Allaah SWT forgave them: "Rabbana zhalamna an fusina wa il-lam taghfir lana wa tar hamna lana koonanna minal khaasireen!" "Our Lord! We have truly wronged our own souls, and if You do not forgive us, we will truly be among the losers!" [7:23] This is the prayer of Prophet Adam & Eve AS. Allaah SWT's peace and blessings on them both Prophet Adam AS's epic spiritual journey began from a state of primordial innocence and went through human forgetfulness, distraction, and disobedience. This was the first Sin. But Allaah SWT also gave Adam AS the ability to recognize his mistake, to regret, to be filled with remorse and to plead for forgiveness, and finally to earn redemption. This is the same journey that you and I and every human being must take. We all were innocent once. We got distracted. We forgot and we sinned. Now it is time to follow Adam AS's example. If you have not yet undertaken this blessed journey, make your intention, your niyyat, to do your Hajj In Sha Allaah, as soon as possible.

On Hajj, you are Allaah SWT's guest. Allaah SWT has invited you to His BaituLaah, His House. As Allaah SWT's honored guest, you must scrupulously observe the good manners that are expected of you. During Hajj,its best behavior at all times. As soon as you put on your ehram, you repeat those evocative words, "Labbaik, Allaah humma labbaik!": "Here I am, O Allaah SWT, Here I am!" Allaah SWT has honored you with His invitation, and now that you have arrived, you announce your presence and your willingness to serve Allaah SWT, as best you can. Hajj is an outward journey tracing the spiritual history of Islam. It is also the inward journey that you and I must undertake, to find our own center, in the Kaaba of our heart.
